Question 124

Which is the third petition?

Answer

Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven;¹ that is, grant that we and all men may renounce our own will,² and without murmuring obey Thy will,³ which is only good; that so every one may attend to and perform the duties of his station and calling⁴ as willingly and faithfully as the angels do in heaven.⁵
